Extract from the Multi-Partite Agreement relating to the Playing of Golf over the Vale Commons with effect from 1 January 2017

SCHEDULE 3

Framework of Environmental Principles

- In their activities on the Commons, the Council and the Clubs shall maintain, protect and enhance the natural environment, delivering benefits to habitats, wildlife, people and landscapes.
- 2. The Council and the Clubs, or the appointed agents of either, shall monitor the effectiveness of the management of the Commons.
- 3. The Council shall promote the sustainable use of the Commons by the public, including in relation to grazing.
- 4. The Council shall raise public awareness of the natural biodiversity of the Commons.
- 5. The Council shall provide any environmental guidance considered necessary in relation to any proposals for use of the Commons for historical, archaeological, agricultural, sporting or recreational activities.
- 6. The Council and the Clubs shall take into account the advice of other relevant bodies in the Island in respect of environmental matters, including the Royal Society for the Protection of Birds, La Société Guernesiaise, the National Trust and other relevant experts in their respective fields.
- 7. The way in which the Clubs and the Council give effect to Principles 1 to 6 above in this Schedule 3 must always take account of the need to maintain a golf course on the Commons in accordance with the rest of this agreement.
